



Feel free to observe court any Monday or Tuesday morning at 9:30 a.m. if you would like to see our Montgomery County Child advocates in action. Just print out this map and head over to the CASA office at around 9:00 a.m. which is located in downtown Conroe. Next, pick up your visitors badges placed on top of the CASA advocate desk at the entrance of our CASA office. Feel free to meet the staff and other advocates while at the CASA office before you head to the court house. As you can see from the map, the courthouse is just a quick 2 block walk from the CASA office. The CPS court room is located at 301 North Main street courthouse in Conroe, Texas. The Montgomery County presiding Judge that hears our CPS cases is Judge Ottis. Her courtroom is located on the first floor of the courthouse. It is the first courtroom on the right side of the security station. Make sure to pick up your visitor's badge first located on the advocate desk at the entrance of the CASA office before you attend court. Also, do not forget to turn off your cell before entering the court room. Judge Ottis has a 50.00 fine for a cell ringing in her court room. If you are still interested in becoming a Court Appointed Special Advocate after observing court, submit your completed application to the Training Director, Mark Goerlitz and set up a time to discuss signing up for the next training class.
